



Fireplace restoration is another specialty that we offer. We can address safety issues in fireplaces in homes on the National Historical Register, upgrade fireplaces that smoke or have been damaged by chimney fire and replace metal “heatilator” type fireplaces that have been deteriorated by the effects of rain and heat. We have developed our own unique method, based on fluid dynamic experiments for reconfiguring the smoke chamber using a site-cast inner lintel and refractory cement parging over a metal lath armature to remedy many problems in this area of the fireplace inner structure.
